NEW ACADEMIC YEAR STARTING FROM JUNE

The academic year for the previous 4 years has been rotating alongside the school system of September to September but now that Ramadhan is moving away towards shorter fasts we were planning to return towards the old system of Ramadhan to Ramadhan because we think this will be the best way for the Madrasah to progress forward. However due to the issues we have faced this year of the pandemic, we have decided to return to the old system sooner rather than later.

Therefore our new academic year will start after this Ramadhan and end before next Ramadhan.

As a result, few amendments have been made;

There will be no formal end of year exam, Jalsa and Sumer holidays.

Classes will resume week commencing 1st June and continuing during the summer holidays with the exception of 2 weeks of August for Eid ul Adha. (Hifz class will be closed for an additional 1 week).

CHANGING CLASSES

As the new academic year will start after Ramadhan the children will be placed into their new academic year classes.

Class 1 will move into class 2 hence attending Madrasah from 6.00pm till 7:30pm.

Class 2 will move into class 3 and into full time education (5.00pm till 7.30pm).

Class 9 & 7 (older boys and girls) we plan to complete their Quran and they graduate after completion.

The date for the new children to start Class 1 will be decided later.

MADRASAH TEACHING ONLINE (ZOOM)

The madrasah has decided to remain closed for longer, we are now hoping to start online teaching via an app called ZOOM (some parents will already be aware of this as some classes have already started using zoom). You will need to download the app on any device you prefer; laptop, tablet, mobile etc. After downloading this we will send you a Meeting ID along with a password that you will need to join a meeting with the teacher at the allocated time given.

MOVING FORWARD (MADRASAH OPENS PARTIALLY)

In line with the schools and government guidance we will open Madrasah gradually starting from smaller classes with staggered timings for shorter duration, and then eventually open the whole Madrasah.

We will contact you on how this will work.

FEES (NO FEES TO BE PAID FOR APRIL AND MAY)

Due to Madrasah not taking place over the pandemic period the fees of April and May 2020 will not be charged (besides Hifz class).

Some parents, who have already paid their fees for April and onwards, we will deduct the amount already paid from the new academic year's fees.

If not paying via bank, the fees are to be bought in an envelope with the exact amount and the child/ren name, amount and class written clearly on it. Envelopes need to be handed into the head teacher's office.

The fees amount from the New Year from June is as follows (paid monthly):

Class 2	£34
Class 3 upto 9	£36
Hifz class	£40

An enrolment fee has to be paid at the starting of every academic year of **£60** per household, for the remaining payments and dates, please refer to your children's new planner (given out in June).
